- ✓ "Lights out" means it is time to get some rest. So when the lights go off at night, turn off your cell phones and any other distracting electronics. If using a music player with headphones, please keep the noise level low. Please be quiet and respectful of your roommates that are trying to sleep.
- ✓ The kitchen, stage, and church office are off-limits to students unless otherwise specified.
